**BILL S-6 (2014)**

The Yukon and Nunavut Regulatory Improvement Act

**40 amendments**

More than ¾ of the amendments in Bill S-6 do not come from the 5 Year Review but through Canada's agenda supported by Yukon Government.

Canada introduced these amendments late in the process. The amendments YFN oppose were introduced in detail with less than 2 months to comment

They also introduced last minute changes to these proposed amendments and told us no further changes will be contemplated .
