



REEES Champions needed

Looking for committee members to help oversee the analysis and dissemination of Yukon REEES

- REEES stands for the Regional Education, Employment and Early Childhood Development Survey, a national First Nations survey carried out by the First Nations Information Governance Centre (FNIGC) in Ottawa and its regional partners which included CYFN.
- Over 250 First Nations communities from across Canada took part and in the Yukon more than 1400 citizens from all Yukon First Nations were surveyed. REEES collected key information in the areas of education, employment and early childhood development using the First Nations principles of OCAP™ (Ownership, Control, Access and Possession) that can be used to support decision-making and planning in First Nations communities, governments and organizations.
- Since data from the REEES will soon be released CYFN is looking for committee members who can participate in the analysis and dissemination of data pertaining to REEES. Ideally we are looking for Yukon First Nation citizens who have expertise in the areas of education, employment or early childhood development in their community.
- As the Yukon First Nations own the data generated by this survey, and this data is returned to them, there is an ongoing commitment by CYFN to involve and train citizens from every community in data analysis and to have them participate in the culturally informed analysis of all Yukon REEES data.
- Therefore CYFN is asking every Yukon First Nation to nominate a citizen for the Yukon REEES Analysis and Dissemination Committee. Committee members will assist with the culturally informed analysis of the Yukon REEES data and play an active role in the analysis of the REEES data pertaining to their own community.
