Respectful Travel within Kluane First Nation's Traditional Territory Yukoners

When visiting our local businesses:

- Please respect and abide by all safety guidelines of that business;
- Respect the 2 metres/6 feet safe personal space of all other patrons;
- Do not make extra unnecessary stops in our community; and
- Do not linger and visit outside businesses or in public spaces.

Please DO NOT:

- Explore or tour our neighborhoods and private residences;
- Visit or stay at any facility that is closed;
- Camp on or travel through First Nation Settlement Lands without permission; and
- Leave behind garbage, waste, sewage, etc. on our lands and waters.

To other travelers passing through

(people from outside the Yukon allowed to transit through to or from Alaska or NWT):

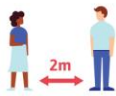





- Please abide by the 24-hour limit ordered by the Government of Yukon to pass through our territory.
- Please stay on the route directed by the Governments of Yukon and Canada.
- Please do not stop in our community unless you have an emergency.
- Please adhere to all other Canada and Yukon orders and measures.
- Respect all guidance listed here.

We hope you'll visit us again when the risk of COVID-19 is no longer present.

1. Please be advised when travelling that our Government Office is CLOSED to the Public
2. Do not visit our government buildings without an appointment.
3. There is NO Camping on our Settlement Land without permission.

6 Steps to Staying Safe

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|  | 1 Physical distancing – keep 2 metres away from everyone who's not a member of your household |  | 3 Stay home if you're feeling sick |  | 5 Limit travel to rural communities |
|  | 2 Wash your hands frequently with soap and water, or use hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol |  | 4 Don't gather in groups of more than 10 people and remember to keep 2 metres apart |  | 6 Self-isolate if you've just returned to the territory or if you've been in contact with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 |
