

# Revised COVID-19 Emergency Measures Take Effect on August 6, 2021

**On Friday August 6**, Council voted to **extend the Emergency Declaration** on Settlement Land until November 6, 2021 so we can continue to protect everyone in our community, especially the most vulnerable. Council also voted to **revise the COVID-19 Emergency Measures** to help support community wellness. We've made good progress with vaccinations in Old Crow, but we're not out of the woods yet!

## The Revised Emergency Measures are:

1. Anyone aged 12 and up entering Old Crow must self-isolate unless they have provided Council with proof they received both doses of their COVID-19 vaccination at least 14 days before arriving in the community.
2. Anyone in the community who comes into close contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 must immediately notify the Old Crow nursing station (966-4444) and notify Council.
3. Anyone experiencing COVID-19 symptoms such as cold and flu-like must self-isolate in their own residence and notify the Nursing Station.
4. Masks must be worn in all indoor and outdoor public spaces.

## Exceptions:

Anyone required to self-isolate must remain in their own home for 14 days, **with only the following exceptions:**

If you provide Council with proof of a negative COVID-19 test result in the past 24 hours you can end your self-isolation once you receive confirmation from Council.

If you are a self-isolating, you can:

- Be in a social bubble with people from up to one other residence other than your own.
- Access outdoor public spaces on Settlement Land as long as you are at least 2-metres away from other people.
- Access the VGFN Traditional Territory beyond Settlement Land for traditional pursuits while complying with all other emergency measures.
