The Council of Yukon First Nations is pleased to announce that the Site Blessing and Groundbreaking Ceremony for the Family Preservation Wellness Centre will take place on May 17th, 2023. See enclosed invitation for details. The project has secured the necessary permits and funding to begin construction. We are excited to be sharing this milestone with you.

The project was previously referred to as the Shelter for Indigenous Women and Children. The new Family Preservation Wellness Centre name is now being used to better communicate the family-centered services that will be provided to guests.

We are writing to notify you that the construction team will begin mobilizing on the site as early as May 18th, 2023. The construction period is anticipated to extend to the fall of 2024. All work will be conducted in accordance with City of Whitehorse bylaws, and if needed, you may receive notifications from relevant contractors should there be any work that may disrupt regular traffic flow in the area. Once the Contractor has established the site perimeter security fencing and offices, contact information will be made visible on the fencing should any issues or concerns related to the site arise.
